With a grant from the William T. Grant Foundation, Professor **Cecilia Ayon** is studying whether sanctuary city policies have beneficial effects on the mental health of Latinx children in immigrant families.



With a grant from New York University, Professor **Bruce Link** is researching the impacts of genetic attributions on the clinical high risk state for psychosis.



Through a grant from the Eastern Municipal Water District Professor **Kurt Schwabe** is researching the actors that contribute to community members being delinquent in water bills and facing service disconnections, with attention to one's income status among other factors.



Via a National Science Foundation grant, Professor **Qingfang Wang** is studying the impact of COVID-19 stay-at-home orders on U.S. economic activity, particularly small businesses.
